

THE IMPORTANCE OF DIGITAL SKILLS & MOBILE TOOLS IN EVERYDAY LIFE


- In times of physical distancing, such as during the COVID-19 pandemic, people are likely to turn to digital communication to replace in-person interactions.

HOW IS MOBILE APP DEVELOPED?

- Mobile application development is the process of creating software applications that run on a mobile device. A typical mobile application utilizes a network connection to work with remote computing resources;
- As almost everyone has some sort of smartphone in their pocket at all times, the ability to access huge amounts of information online is very useful in our everyday lives – mobilie apps can serve many puproses to end users and whole communities;
- There are different categories of mobile application, depending on their purpose (e.g. communications, games, multimedia, producativity, travel, utilities)

- As a big part of our everyday life has moved to the online sphere – out life is strongly connected to being "online";

Digital communication in different situations


Online environments have done the communication locally and globally easier than ever before.
